# LESS TRASH MORE THRASH

## WASTE SEPARATION MADE EASY – PRE-PACKED THRASHER PACKAGES



To make it easier for you to separate your garbage, pre-prepared packages filled with yellow and black garbage bags will be handed out at the entrance gates to the festival site. The 40,000 Thrasher bags were packed by Lebenshilfe Ansbach e.V. at the workshop in Feuchtwangen. The paper bags were produced right next door at the paper goods factory VP Group.

## STRONG DISPOSAL TEAM – OUR THRASHER TEAM



During the festival, our Thrasher team consists of over 40 people and cleans the entire festival area of over 120 hectares. Afterwards, the waste separated by you will be disposed of in the containers provided backstage.

## BIODEGRADABLE DISPOSABLE TABLEWARE



Our food stands must use biodegradable disposable tableware at their stands. The food retailers were allowed to choose the right tableware from a selection of predetermined product ranges.

We will check compliance with this requirement on site.

## DISPOSAL CONCEPT FOR FOOD STANDS AT THE SUMMER BREEZE



Our food stands are also included in the disposal process. To ensure fair disposal, we not only sort recyclables, residual waste and paper, but also food waste and used glass (a rare exception to the glass ban).

## NUMEROUS GARBAGE STATIONS ON THE FESTIVAL GROUND



At almost 50 waste stations and at all SHIT 'N' SHOWER STATIONS you will have the opportunity to separate your waste into residual waste, paper and yellow bags. We are counting on you to take advantage of the short distances and keep your camps and the site clean. In addition, yellow and black garbage bags will be handed out at all SHIT 'N' SHOWER STATIONS.

Our waste stations are emptied daily by our Thrasher teams and sorted accordingly at the recycling station.

## DEPOSIT STATIONS AT ALL SHIT 'N' SHOWER STATIONS



Last year, our pledge team Crowdpadding was able

to collect EUR 60,000 in donations with just your help. To make this easier, this year there is an extra category for pledges for all SHIT 'N' SHOWER STATIONS.

## FOODSHARING STAND



Stop by the food sharing stand and help to throw away as little food as possible!

At this stand you can hand in food, swap food or simply take other food that has been handed in. The diligently collected and leftover food will be donated after the festival.

## DEALING WITH WATER AROUND THE SUMMER BREEZE



Reduced water consumption thanks to vacuum flush toilets, sewer-friendly composition of sanitary fluids in our portable toilets. Only reduced use of chemicals allows waste water to be fed into the regional systems.

## OUR PROTECTION CONCEPT



Behind the scenes, our crew also implements the manners that we want to see in front of the stages and on the campsite.

In order to ensure peaceful coexistence, a preventive protection concept has been drawn up for all crew members, service providers and other employees. From the organizer's point of view, the code of conduct is set out here and we call on crew members to adhere to it.

## AWARENESS TENT



We want a festival where no one feels uncomfortable, threatened or discriminated against.

That's why the Awareness Tent is available around the clock as a safe space and point of contact.

This year, for the first time, the Awareness Team is being provided entirely by the SUMMER BREEZE crew. The team is made up of trained professionals with backgrounds in social work, Malteser emergency staff with psychosocial support training, and works in close coordination with our security team.

You can recognize them by their black safety vests marked "AWARENESS TEAM."

## METALITY



The Metality team supports festivalgoers with disabilities – helping them set up tents, settle into their camp, or even carry a crate of beer.

On departure day, the team also collects leftover camping gear and donates it to charitable causes. You'll find collection points at all shower camp areas.

## SERVICE FOR PEOPLE IN A WHEELCHAIR



Together with Sanitätshaus FEIX from Dinkelsbühl and Metality e.V. we will be offering a service for wheelchair users on the festival site. A wide range of services will be provided from wheelchair repairs to assistance with arrival and setting up the camp.

There are also barrier-free platforms for people with disabilities on all main stages.

## DRINK INFORMATION IN BRAILLE:



To improve accessibility, information about the available drinks is also provided in Braille at almost all beverage stands.

## EASY ARRIVAL BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT



A comfortable journey to the SUMMER BREEZE site with Deutsche Bahn coupled with our shuttle service is possible without any problems. On site, travelers without a vehicle are provided with practical parking spaces directly behind the main entrance.

## CARLESS CAMPING



Special camping area reserved for those arriving without a vehicle. Directly behind the box office to avoid long distances.

## GREEN CAMPING



The demand was loud – and we listened:

The Green Camp area has been expanded this year and now offers even more space for everyone who wants to camp without generators and in a cleaner, more eco-conscious environment.

For the first time, there will also be a proper compost disposal option available in this area.

## ROUNDTABLE – GREEN REGULARS' TABLE



The Green Festival Roundtable brings together people from the music and festival scene during the event itself.

The goal: to exchange ideas on the current challenges of sustainable event planning, learn from each other, and develop shared solutions.
